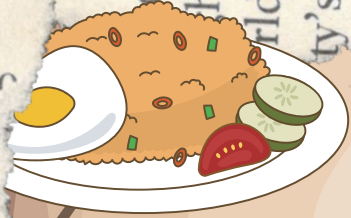
TRAINING SESSION ON FIREFIGHTING & SAFETY

GERMAN RECIPE CORNER: SPÄTZLE

Serves 4

A beloved comfort food from southern Germany, Spätzle are soft, homemade egg noodles that can be enjoyed as a side dish or as a meal on their own. Topped with buttery toasted breadcrumbs, they are simple, hearty, and delicious.

Ingredients

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 tsp salt

2 eggs

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup milk

$\frac{1}{2}$ cup fine dry bread crumbs

$\frac{1}{4}$ cup butter or margarine, melted

Method

1. In a mixing bowl, combine the flour and salt.
2. In a separate bowl, whisk together the eggs and milk, then gradually stir the mixture into the flour until a smooth batter is formed.
3. Bring a large pot of salted water to a rolling boil.
4. Place the batter into a Spätzle maker or a colander with large holes (approximately $\frac{3}{16}$ inch (4.75 mm) in diameter). Press the batter through the holes directly into the boiling water to form the Spätzle.
5. Cook for about 5 minutes, stirring gently until the Spätzle are tender. Drain thoroughly.
6. Mix the melted butter with the fine breadcrumbs and drizzle the mixture over the cooked Spätzle before serving.

Serving Suggestion: Enjoy Spätzle as a traditional accompaniment to German meat dishes, or serve it on its own with sautéed onions and cheese for a classic Käsespätzle.
